Dear Gov. Corbett,

Fifteen million people depend on the Delaware River basin for clean water. But unconventional gas drilling threatens our watershed with toxins, including carcinogens such as benzene, formaldehyde, and radium 226. Shale gas drilling also releases air pollution and greenhouse gases.

Please tell your Commissioner on the Delaware River Basin Commission not to finalize rules for shale gas drilling until related greenhouse gas emissions are regulated; until the EPA study on hydrofracking's risks to water and air is complete; and until the Cumulative Impact Study for the Basin is assessed. *Protect our river and our health: study first!*
